St Joseph's Primary School has considered the strengths and area to develop for the school, in consultation with stakeholders and in analysing our equality information. We have set ourselves the following objectives:

Objective 1 (**Accessibility** within the Learning Environment):

Ensure that the **disadvantaged and vulnerable** children are achieving their full potential in all areas of development. *"Jesus came so we could have life and have it to the full." John 10:10. (Link to SIP key priority 5)*

Objective 2 (SEND):

Ensure that staff communicate their **expectations of learning** and **behaviour** clearly and consistently throughout lessons- recognising that additional support will be necessary for those with SEN and SALT, especially with year group teacher changes and new teachers to school, and within our vulnerable year groups (EYFS/Year 1 and Year 3)(learning behaviours)

Objective 3 (SEND):
