Each child had to compete in two track and two field events over the course of the evening. Points were awarded out of 8 for each discipline. St. Joseph's managed to score 140 points and therefore winning the event 26 points ahead of the second place school Mudeford Juniors. They now go through to the next round at Purbeck School on 28th January to compete against the other winning schools in the Purbeck and Christchurch areas.
